

## MSTA Kent King Educator Scholarship

## ATTENTION CTA PRESIDENT, COUNSELOR AND APPLICANT:

The Missouri State Teachers Association will award one non-renewable \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior planning a career in education in each MSTA region of the state.

Candidates must present evidence of good character, good scholarship and an aptitude for college.

The recipients of the scholarships must enroll as full-time students at a college or university in preparation for the teaching profession. Upon proof of enrollment, a check for \$500 will be issued to the recipient.

Full and explicit answers to all questions on the application are necessary. There will be no interviews of the student applicants selected.

The completed applications must be returned to the school counselor or principal by May 1 in order to allow time for consideration by the local MSTA Community Teachers Association for submission to the state MSTA.

The local CTA will collect the applications from the school counselor or principal in order to select one for submission to the state MSTA. Each CTA may submit only one student application, which must be signed by the CTA president. If you are unsure who serves as the local CTA president, call 1-800-392-0532.
